Gothicised Italic with Rosa Parsloe

We shall study the techniques of Gothicised Italic in 1½ – 1 Mitchell nib or equivalent. You will progress at your own pace. The day is suitable for all levels of experience.

Later we shall use a variety of nibs from small to Automatic size 3A – 4. There will be nibs to share. A3 paper is advisable, with some weight to it, heavyweight cartridge etc.

We shall use colour for the hand and for the spaces. Bring gouache, watercolour crayons and inks if you have them, I will have some to share.

You may work on some of your own coloured background paper if you wish.
