A "hand" essential for every calligrapher's repertoire. We will cover, at a pace appropriate to the individual, the proportions, construction and spacing of letters and words, followed by developing examples of letter weights and variations of form. These should provide a useful resource for future design ideas which we will also discuss.

Suitable for all levels.

Materials & Equipment Needed

- Your usual which should include:
- Writing board, size suitable for using
- Your HP smooth cartridge paper size A3 not A4.
- For first exercise, and to save time, everyone please bring pre-ruled (LANDSCAPE) on A3 cartridge paper, writing lines 16 mm apart with 5mm interline space.
- For the more experienced, not beginners – HP paper with a slightly toothed surface. I will have some to purchase.
- Ruler 18ins/45cms
- Sharp pencils HB or H, plus sharpener and eraser
- Pen-holders, reservoirs and Wm Mitchell (or equivalent) nibs – sizes 0 to 5. (Automatic pens could be equivalent to WM M size 0.)
- Non waterproof black calligraphy ink or Schmincke/Windsor & Newton ivory 'black designers' gouache for mixing in dish, plus brush, water pot, tissues.
